As we navigate a changing world, philanthropy must also evolve to meet the shifting needs of individuals, families, and communities worldwide.

The Entertainment Industry Foundation responded to calls for help from thousands of people impacted by climate disasters this year. Oprah Winfrey and Dwayne Johnson, with the guidance of EIF, launched a fund to address the immediate needs of the people of Maui by delivering funds directly to residents' bank accounts. People's Fund of Maui paid \$30 million to 8,100 residents in just three months and continued into the next year to provide nearly \$60 million in total. We were honored to support these efforts and to serve at the forefront of an innovative approach to disaster relief

Our EIF Careers Program expanded its alliance to include key stakeholders from entertainment, the Los Angeles School District, and the State of California. These efforts, along with those of our new fiscally sponsored funds, including Devin Booker Starting Five and SI20 Foundation, launched by WNBA star Sabrina Ionescu, provide opportunities to historically excluded communities and build on our commitment to improving the lives of young people.

This year, the importance of collaboration to solve complex issues was demonstrated in public service announcements EIF co-produced with partners, which focused on issues ranging from mental health to disaster preparedness to the effects of social media on young people.

Together, we're effectively addressing the complexities of a rapidly shifting landscape. Thank you for your support of EIF and all of our partners.

Founded in 1942 by Hollywood icons Samuel Goldwyn, Humphrey Bogart, Joan Crawford, James Cagney, and the Warner brothers, the Entertainment Industry Foundation (EIF) is a multifaceted organization that occupies a unique place in the world of philanthropy.

By mobilizing and leveraging the powerful voices and creative talents of the entertainment industry and cultivating the support of organizations and philanthropists committed to social responsibility, EIF builds awareness and raises funds, developing and enhancing programs on the local, national, and global levels to facilitate positive social change.

Throughout its history, EIF has focused on some of the most pressing needs of our time, from wartime aid for agencies like the United States Organizations and the American Red Cross to eradicating child polio and other critical health, disaster relief, and social issues.

We have raised over \$1 billion and support hundreds of charities each year.

Today, EIF is committed to increasing access for emerging industry talent.







On May 16, 2024, the EIF Careers Program and Entertainment Equity Alliance partners hosted the inaugural Careers in Entertainment Expo, bringing together 1400+ young adults, high school, and college students to learn about Arts, Media, and Entertainment career pathways.

The Expo featured 35+ exhibitors, including:

- Workforce training and community-based organizations
- Postsecondary career education programs
- Labor union training programs
- Employer-sponsored internships and early career programs

From behind-the-scenes insights to hands-on demonstrations, students had the opportunity to engage directly with experts and gain practical knowledge about entertainment careers. Students were invited to attend a panel discussion featuring the cast and crew of SWEETWATER, a 2023 biographical sports film about Nat Clifton, the first African-American to sign a contract with the NBA.





In its fifteenth year of connecting young women with powerful female Hollywood executives, The Hollywood Reporter's Women in Entertainment Mentorship Program looked to EIF for enhanced financial and administrative support.

In partnership with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Greater Los Angeles, the EIF Careers Program team provides opportunities for re-engagement with past mentors and mentees, focusing on growth and greater, longer-term impact.

Collaboration with the Roybal School of Film and Television Production Fund and other EIF-rooted activities is opening doors.











Defy:Disaster is the entertainment community's collective and immediate response to natural disasters. Its work in 2024 included supporting communities devastated by Hurricane Helene, which swept across Florida before causing catastrophic flooding in North Carolina and the Southeast. The hurricane destroyed homes and businesses and left residents without power, communication, food, or water.

Ukraine Children's Action Project (UCAP), an EIF fund, continued to uplift Ukrainian children displaced by the war. UCAP's Weekend School helped preserve students' national identity and culture. Its Recovery Camps hosted and supported more than 4,650 children and mothers who lived near the frontlines of the war, and the fund is helping to rebuild schools in Lviv damaged in the war.

Launched by Oprah Winfrey and Dwayne Johnson, the People's Fund of Maui provided direct financial assistance to the people of Lahaina and Kula who experienced losses from the devastating Maui wildfires. It was created in close collaboration and with guidance from local Maui elders and community leaders who offered insight and their blessing of the fund.

More than 8,100 residents received monthly disbursements of \$1,200, with \$60 million distributed to the people of Maui.

An in-person support center was created in West Maui to provide assistance with the application process, and a Maui call center was available seven days a week to offer help to residents.







Stand Up To Cancer (SU2C) raises awareness and funds research to detect and treat cancers, with the aspiration of curing all patients.

2024 was a year of considerable progress in cancer research. SU2C hosted their annual SU2C Scientific Summit and two crucial innovation summits. These events reflected the core goal of fostering collaboration, catalyzed conversations about their scientific strategy, and helped SU2C set a bold agenda for the future. The two innovation summits featured emerging possibilities in cancer research, such as harnessing the significant potential of AI and therapeutic vaccines.

In 2024, SU2C provided new research grants, ranging from foundational science that answers critical questions about cancer biology to clinical trials that test novel combination therapies.


